This pamphlet contains the preliminary results of the 2010 FSM-Wide Census. These results are made available to the public so as to give some idea of the population growth as well as its distribution.

It is worth highlighting that the 2010 census has recorded fewer residents compared to 2000, which is the result of substantial net-migration over the past decade.

The 2010 data presented is provisional, therefore, subject to change after validation processes are completed and the data is finalized.

Figure 1A. Age-sex structure, CHUUK: 2010

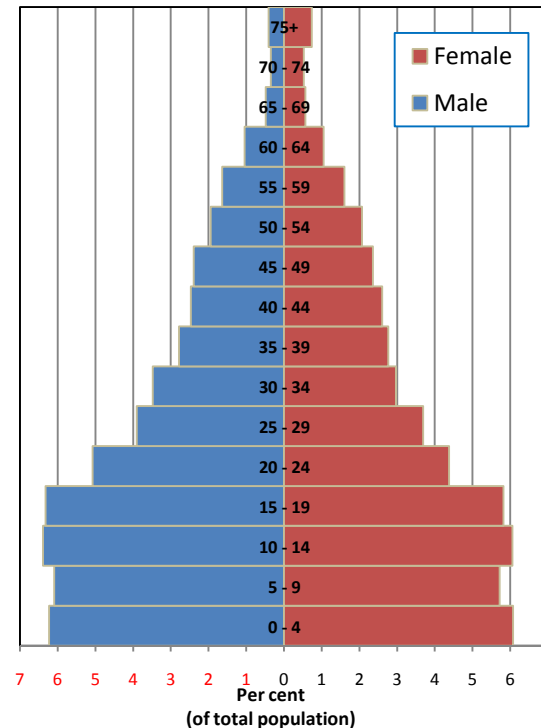

Figure 1B. Population by Year, 1925-2010

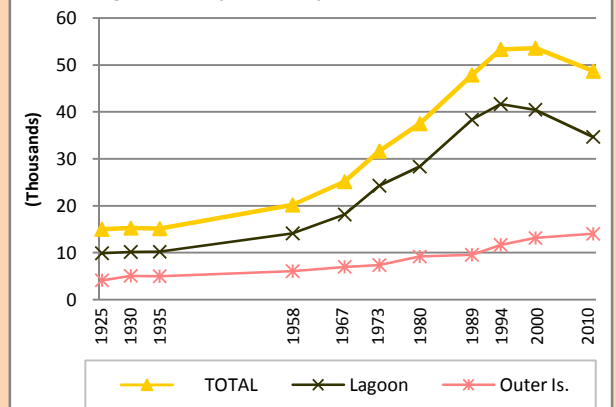
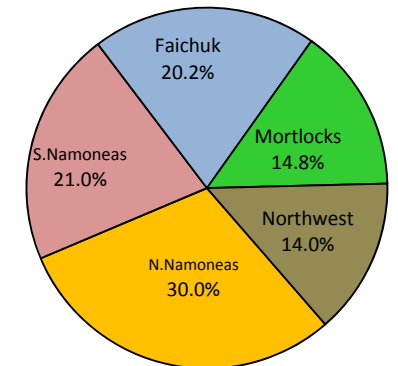


Figure 1C. Population (%) by Region of Usual Residence: 2010
