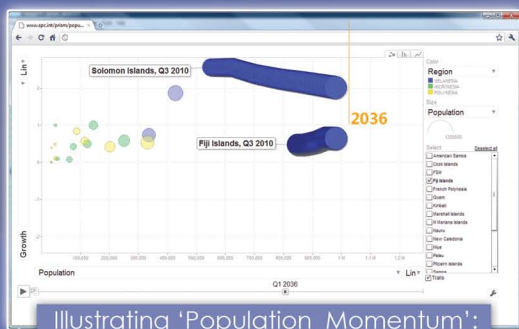

Enhance data access, transparency and value through documentation and unit record outputs

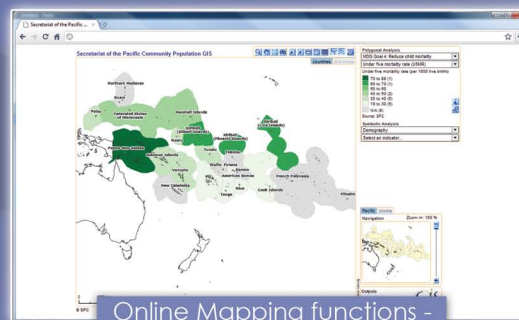


Data Dissemination
